Statement of Support/Consent

Purpose

It is the purpose of John Knox Christian School to provide a sound academic education based upon, and infused with, the truth of God's written and created word. While the school remains basically interdenominational, and does not teach any particular church's doctrines, the instructional program is specifically based on the infallible Word of God as interpreted in the doctrinal standards and confessions of the historic orthodox Christian churches; in so far as they apply to education.

Philosophy

The educational program and the methods of instruction at John Knox Christian School are based on Biblical truths to provide the orientation upon which general background truth, and principles of interpreting the facts encountered in the study of our subjects are understood. We understand that the Biblical concepts of a Christian Education are these:

1. Our triune God is the Creator and sustainer of all things, and the source of all truth.
2. He has revealed Himself in a general way in His world and universe, and in a specific way in the Bible.
3. That fallen, sinful man was created perfect, in God's image; to enjoy covenantal fellowship with his Creator, and is to reflect in his person and work, the task given to him by God. This task is to have dominion over the world in loving obedience to God and His glory.
4. That our Lord Jesus Christ reconciled the sinful world to God and through his suffering, death and resurrection, redeems our life in its entirety.
5. That human life in its entirety is religion, that is, service to God. The Christian is not to be conformed to the world but must recognize his responsibility and his role to live a totally Christian life in society.
6. That God has given these children into our care and has given unique abilities to each student. It is the teacher's responsibility to nurture and challenge each child according to their ability and to seek to teach them at their academic level.
7. The teacher stands in the place of the parent.
8. The home, church, and school should complement each other; promoting spiritual, academic, social and physical growth.
9. The student's home, church, school experience and training should be a preparation for life; a life of dedication and fellowship with God, and service to mankind.
